Workshop on "Intellectual Property Rights & Patents and Design Filing"

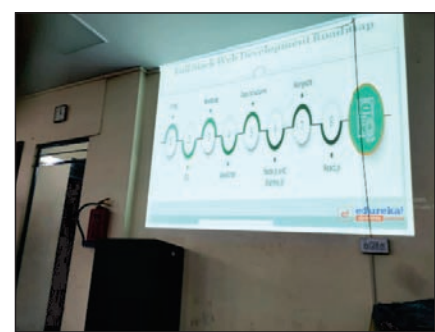
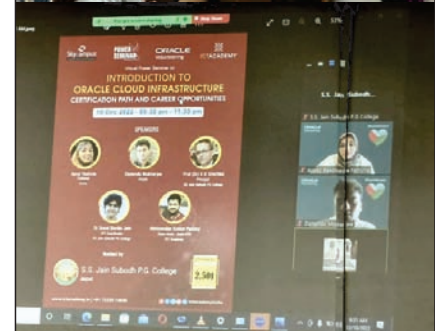

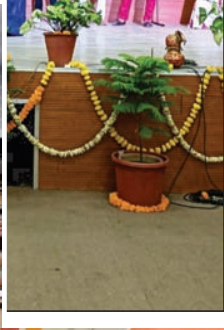
