- Availability of medical assistance at campus, when required Get Vaccinated, Stay Safe


























The vision of Subodh

RESEARCH CENTRES

The college promotes research oriented approach to enrich the Teaching-Learning environment in the college. At present four separate educational Research Centres exist in Physics, Computer Science, Mathematics and Commerce Department.

**Department of Physics** is involved in three core areas of research:

- 1. Microwave Electronics group: (Research lead by Prof. K.B. Sharma) The centre has high-end facilities like Generators, Wave Guides, Measuring Instruments, Radiating and receiving antennas, Vector Network Analyzer (VNA) and Anechoic Chamber.
- 2. Energy Storage group: (Research lead by Dr. Balram Tripathi) This centre is equipped with Composite fabrication setup, Hydrogen storage setup, Impedance analyzer, Charging-discharging setup.
- 3. Condensed Matter Physics group: (Researchers: Dr. S.C. Agarwal and Dr. S.P. Pareek) The centre has the facilities viz. Thin Film Coating Unit, Hydraulic Press Unit (20 ton), Nano-materials Synthesis Unit, Muffle Furnace (10000°C), Magnetic Stirrers, Pelletizer and Digital Microbalance,
- Dr. S. C. Agarwal, Dr. Balram Tripathi and Dr. S.P. Pareek of Department of Physics are the research supervisors approved by University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

Department of Mathematics: Department of Mathematics has a Research centre approved by University of Rajasthan, Jaipur for conduction of Ph. D. program. Its research activities encompass a broad range of areas including Special Function, Operation research, Relativity, Fluid Dynamics etc.. Some ongoing activities include distinguished lecture & workshops, research seminars and visitor program. Centre has a computer lab with latest version computers equipped with softwares like 'MATHEMATICA', 'SCILAB' and many other software which are very useful in research area.

Department of Computer Science: It has a Computer Science and Application Research Centre approved by Rajasthan Technical University, Kota for the conduction of Ph.D. programme in the areas of Business Intelligence, Software Engineering, Big Data Analytics, and Internet of Things. The Research center has latest infrastructure, latest hardware and software, Plagiarism software for quality publication, UGC approved Journals, video conferencing unit for outreach activities and high speed internet connection. It is also functioning as a remote centre of

It provides an opportunity to enrich knowledge and enhance research profile of the students and faculty. The laboratories are well equipped with computers loaded with latest software helpful for research, various national international research journals and books on research methodology and rich collection of latest economic reviews along with annual reports of various financial and banking institutions.

#### WI-FI ENABLED CAMPUS

The demand of the Digital India is to provide the latest information. With a view to abreast the students with the latest local and global updates in their field of interest, the college has a Wi-Fi enabled campus which facilitates access to the requisite information anytime, anywhere in the campus. It helps in maintaining continuity in learning and results in digital empowerment of students. Each student in the college is provided Wi-Fi access with a unique individual login ID and space on LAN server with a separate e-mail address.

#### **ITCENTRE**

IT centre in the college campus is equipped with 450 computers, all licensed softwares, internet facility and high speed networking system. The centre also provides scanner, LCDs, printers, drivers, stylers, webcams for video conferencing and internet facility that ensures smooth inter-departmental and intra / inter-institutional information exchange. The students and college staff has an easy access to the IT Centre and are provided technical help through the trained IT staff of the centre.

#### VIDEO CONFERENCING

Video Conferencing has made its way into the teaching practices of the Subodh College. #### **VSATSMARTCLASSROOMS**


#### **CENTRAL INSTRUMENTATION LABORATORY**



- Entry in the library is strictly through Identity cum Library card.
- Two books to UG level students and three books to PG level students can be issued at a time for 14 days and if the book is not in demand the same can be reissued for further 14 days.
- If the book is not deposited in scheduled time, a fine of Rs. 10/-per day per book will be charged.
- If the issued book is lost, the responsibility has to be borne by the borrower and he/she has to deposit another copy of the book of the same or the latest edition. If the book is not replaced, one has to deposit double cost of the book as a fine.
- Any damage caused to the library property and books of the library, in terms of writing, underlining or tearing the pages, is subjected to the disciplinary action as per the college rules.
- As the library is automated /computerized hence, any damage caused to the barcode of the book is subjected to a fine of Rs. 100/-for each book.
- Students have to pay Rs. 100/-for the loss of Identity cum Library card.
- Apart from the above rules, the library has a booklet of rules and regulations which is available at the counter.



Any activity that amounts to teasing and results in any kind of harm to the student is a punishable act and is strictly prohibited. Maintaining the dignity of an individual is the topmost concern at Subodh. The college is proactive against any kind of teasing, harassment or ragging of students. The college cell, as per UGC guidelines, has a Vigilance Squad afety of students in general and girls in specific. The college premises, ridors are equipped with CCTV cameras and facilitate video laboratories and co surveillance at all hours. Victimized students of ragging may seek help from the

The Anti-Ragging Cell is responsible for maintaining a healthy atmosphere in the college by patrolling the activities of the students and taking action against the students who are found involved in such practices. All the students in the institution are insured under The New India Assurance Company Ltd. In case of any mishap, the students have a support of the insurance policy. As per policy, sum insured for each student is Rs. 2,00,000/- in the case of accidental death and permanent total disablement along with Rs. 5000/- for Medical and first aid expenses.

#### SUBODH COLLEGE WOMEN GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

In accordance with the guidelines issued by the Women Commission and Government of Rajasthan, our campus has established the Anti-Sexual Harassment cell to handle various gender sensitive issues. The council aims at protecting the rights of the female faculties and students in order to create a safe and complacent environment. It addresses any kind of discrimination and harassment issues that might threaten the dignity of any of its constituents. An environment conducive for safe and secure learning is provided in the institution and a Drop Box has been placed outside the office so that students can easily discuss their issues on gender inequality, violence or any other problem.

#### **GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL**

The major function of this cell is to rectify any complaint of the students. The administration and staff is accountable to solve the problems of the pursuer, to maintain a harmonious educational atmosphere in the institute. The main purpose of the cell is timely amendment of the complaint to the satisfaction of the complainant. #### TOBACCO CONTROL CELL

There is an active Tobacco Control Cell in the campus in order to create a healthy and addiction free environment, by condemning and penalizing any usage of tobacco products within the premises. If anyone violates the rule, Rs 250 may be charged as penalty.

#### MENTOR-MENTEE CELL

Every student is an asset to the college. In keeping with the goal to make its students responsible citizens of the country, Subodh has initiated Mentor-Mentee  $\,$ Cell, which provides guidance and all information related to the student. The mentor keeps the track of all the records of his mentee in terms of his regular competitive exams like CA, CS, CMA, CLAT, CAT, MAT etc. Even mentee can turn to the mentor for any kind of support and guidance. Parents can also come and meet the concerned mentor to know about the well-being of his ward.

#### TRAINING & PLACEMENT CELL

Since last five years, the cell has placed about 5589 students in various companies. The cell also organizes extensive job and career fair with the support of the state government.

#### SCIENCE CLUB

The Science club has the objectives of cultivation of awareness, consciousness and opportunity for learners to explore various aspects of science as well as development of analytical and critical thinking. Various events and activities such as National Science Day, Poster Making Competition, Quiz Competition, Seminar, Guest Lectures and Health Awareness Programmes are organized by this club.
