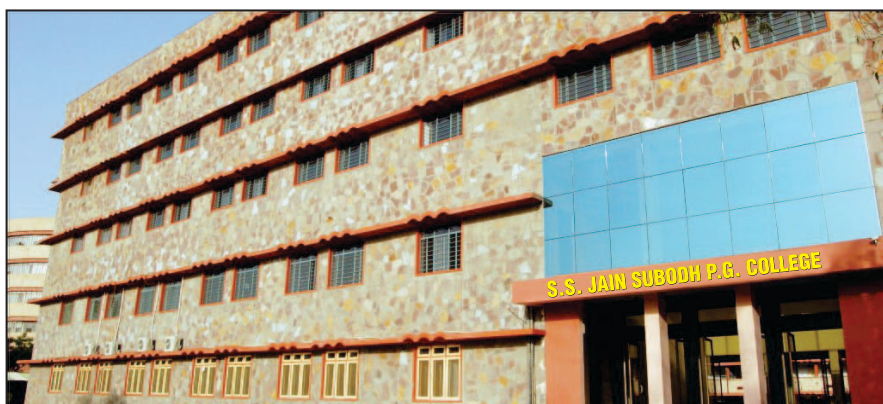

- 2) In March 2021, a MoU had been signed with FIRS Foundation of Club First Robotics with the mission to provide a platform to the students to cultivate their interest in robotics and science for their social robotic development.
- 3) In March 2018, the college had signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Anthropos India Foundation, New Delhi as a constructive step to work together for the betterment of the underprivileged sections of the society. This will involve effective planning of socially beneficial activities like ethnographic/visual documentation women and child issues, advocacy and various awareness programme on social issues.
- 4) In 2017, a MOU had been signed with Institute of Crystallography, Russian Academy of Sciences Moscow, Russia for cross cultural and research activities.
- 5) In 2017, the institution also got associated with ETCO e- waste Recycler Private Limited, Jaipur for the purpose of recycling and disposing the e-waste.
- 6) In 2016, a MoU had been signed with Bauman Moscow State Technical University, Russia leading to development and implementation of Split programmes at undergraduate, post graduate and Ph. D. level along with faculty exchange for the purpose of research. It will not only help in promoting educational development and development of learning and collaborative research but also facilitating exchange programme in the field of culture and sports.
- 7) In 2015, a MoU had been signed with University of Wolverhampton, UK which lead to cultivation and promotion of enriching educational practices through collaborative research and student as well as faculty exchange programmes.
- 8) MoU had been signed with NGO's Upvan Seva Sansthan, Samrishi Society and Samajik Anveshan Avam Shodh Sansthan, to work for the betterment of underprivileged sections of the society. It is a constructive step to carry out beneficial activities like health and hygiene camps, awareness rally, motivational and fun activities etc. for the deprived, needy and less fortunate children living in the orphanages, slums and rehabilitation centers.
- 9) Praveen Lata Sansthan and Satya, All India Welfare Society Girl Child Protection & Promotion are other non-government organizations with whom institution is allied for various activities for deprived and needy children of the society.
- 10) Institution also has the linkage with Bhandari Hospital and Research Centre, Jaipur for providing prompt services, ambulance and other facilities to college staff and their family members.
- 11) College has an authorized centre of RKCL (Rajasthan Knowledge Corporation Limited) to develop a new educational framework which can plan, implement, supervise and regulate the developing needs for IT skills.
- 12) Besides the MoUs with the international bodies, visits of foreign delegates too are a regular feature at the college. In this series, delegates from Dhaka University visited the campus and interacted with the faculty to facilitate cultural exchange as well gain a better understanding about the way academic bodies function in India and the academic systems are defined and executed.
- 13) Earlier MoU's had been signed with Swansea Metropolitan University, UK; Brooksby Melton College, Leicestershire and College Sir Gar to promote research and exchange programmes for staff and students.

# AMENITIES

Infrastructure holds very much importance as college is basically like a second home to the students, a place where they can identify themselves, shape their career and have the expert guidance to walk on the right path. The sprawling college campus spread over an area of ten acres is situated in the heart of the city. An awe inspiring Wi-Fi enabled infrastructure comprising of well ventilated classrooms, science, mathematics, computer and language laboratories aids the process of learning. The multistorey college premise is enriched with latest facilities such as modern amenities and advanced learning resources to cater the need of imparting conceptual and practical knowledge. The institution promotes research activities as per the demand of contemporary scenario. Safety is ensured through manpower security and proper camera surveillance. The college campus proudly hosts green initiatives such as solar panels, rainwater harvesting system, compost plant, segregated bins for wet and dry garbage and sincerely ensures a "no plastic" and "no tobacco" zone.

## RECEPTION

As per the traditional slogan of Rajasthan "Padhaaro Mahre Desh", each visitor is welcomed with warmth and tenderness. Receptionists are usually the very first point of contact with whom students and visitors will be interacting when contacting the college. Various queries regarding admission and day-to-day activities are handled here effectively. It is an active counseling area during the admission period where the representatives of all the Departments are available for career and admission guidance of the aspirants. It greets visitors and show them to the person best suited to assist them.

## AUDITORIUMS

The college has two auditoriums at present. Both the auditoriums have visual delight with a seating capacity of 350 persons each. Each auditorium is centrally air conditioned and exhibits architectural brilliance through its infrastructure which is an amalgamation of the culture and the modern technology. The cultural events and academic presentations come alive in these auditoriums which has technological distinction. They are designed with all updated facilities, in a way that several national and international events can be hosted effortlessly.

## CONFERENCE HALL

Deliberation is a great way to communicate and vital for the development and improvement of an individual and educational system as a whole. For this, the college has air-conditioned conference hall with a seating arrangement for 60 members. The conference hall provides facilities and services for academic meetings, seminars, workshops and conferences. It is equipped with the latest technical gadgets like projection system, Wi-Fi connectivity, electrical and LAN connection for laptops etc.

## SEMINAR HALLS

The college has two seminar halls to conduct academic / non-academic activities for the overall development of students. All the seminar halls have advanced audio-visual facilities, LCD projector with a seating capacity of 400 people taken together. Guest lectures, presentations, workshops, cultural events or any extracurricular / co-curricular activities of the various departments or college can be organized in these seminar halls.

## LECTURE THEATRE

The college has lecture theatre equipped with modern ICT teaching aids and has a seating capacity of 175 students to aid the process of learning. In lecture theatre, various activities like presentations, guest lectures and seminars can be conducted effectively. Apart from this, it is also being used for conducting Industry interaction programs.

## SMART CLASS ROOMS

To keep pace with the technological advancement in pedagogy of teaching and making learning an exhilarating experience, the college has smart class rooms to cater to the smart generation of new India. The college has five smart class rooms which facilitates ICT based learning. They ensure encouragement to smart studies through exploration of web resources and an effective knowledge transfer. The smart classroom enables utilization of the computer, projector, internet and multimedia devices to maintain pace with the modern education scenario.

## OFFICE BLOCK

To streamline and systemize the functioning of the college, the Office-Block comprises of cubicles for office staff along with computers and Wi-Fi connectivity. This block provides information regarding scholarships, fee submission, identity cards etc.





# AMENITIES



## AUTONOMOUS FRONT OFFICE

To keep a pace with the growing requirements of the autonomous activities of the college, a well-furnished Autonomous Front office has been set up in the campus, comprising of highly efficient administrative staff members. Queries related to autonomous status and functioning, examinations, results or any other discipline can be sorted through this block. The working hours of the office are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.



## FACULTY ROOMS

Institution has well ventilated air-cooled faculty rooms with ICT facilities along with pantry and washroom. The faculty members prepare their teaching lessons and presentations as they have access to the high-speed internet facilities through Wi-Fi. Major departments have individual faculty rooms.

## OPEN AIR STAGE

Open air stage is situated at the centre of the college in front of a lush green garden. It is used to conduct various intra and intercollegiate academic and cultural activities viz. debate competition, quiz competition, national science exhibition, techno fair, job fair etc. in the college. It is an open stage having an area in front of it to accommodate more than 2500 spectators.

## RESEARCH CENTRES

The college promotes research oriented approach to enrich the Teaching-Learning environment in the college. At present four separate educational Research Centres exist in Physics, Computer Science, Mathematics and Commerce Department.

**Department of Physics** is involved in three core areas of research:

1. Microwave Electronics group: (Research lead by Prof. K.B. Sharma) The centre has high-end facilities like Generators, Wave Guides, Measuring Instruments, Radiating and receiving antennas, Vector Network Analyzer (VNA) and Anechoic Chamber.
2. Energy Storage group: (Research lead by Dr. Balram Tripathi) This centre is equipped with Composite fabrication setup, Hydrogen storage setup, Impedance analyzer, Charging-discharging setup.
3. Condensed Matter Physics group: (Researchers: Dr. S.C. Agarwal and Dr. S.P. Pareek) The centre has the facilities viz. Thin Film Coating Unit, Hydraulic Press Unit (20 ton), Nano-materials Synthesis Unit, Muffle Furnace (10000°C), Magnetic Stirrers, Pelletizer and Digital Microbalance, Battery tester.

Dr. S. C. Agarwal, Dr. Balram Tripathi and Dr. S.P. Pareek of Department of Physics are the research supervisors approved by University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

**Department of Mathematics** : Department of Mathematics has a Research centre approved by University of Rajasthan, Jaipur for conduction of Ph. D. program. Its research activities encompass a broad range of areas including Special Function, Operation research, Relativity, Fluid Dynamics etc.. Some ongoing activities include distinguished lecture & workshops, research seminars and visitor program. Centre has a computer lab with latest version computers equipped with softwares like 'MATHEMATICA', 'SCILAB' and many other software which are very useful in research area.

**Department of Computer Science** : It has a Computer Science and Application Research Centre approved by Rajasthan Technical University, Kota for the conduction of Ph.D. programme in the areas of Business Intelligence, Software Engineering, Big Data Analytics, and Internet of Things. The Research center has latest infrastructure, latest hardware and software, Plagiarism software for quality publication, UGC approved Journals, video conferencing unit for outreach activities and high speed internet connection. It is also functioning as a remote centre of NITTTR.

Prof. R. R. Sinha, Dr. Leena Bhatia, Mr. Ashish Chandra Swami, Dr. Vikram Jain, Dr. Sonal Bordia Jain, Dr. Vaibhav Sharma and Dr. Vipin Kumar Jain of Department of Computer Science are recognised as Research Supervisors by Rajasthan Technical University, Kota.

**Department of Commerce** : It has established a Commerce Research laboratory, so that, the theoretical knowledge, creativity and efficiency of the faculty and students may result into good results. It provides an opportunity to enrich knowledge and enhance research profile of the students and faculty. The laboratories are well equipped with computers loaded with latest software helpful for research, various national - international research journals and books on research methodology and rich collection of latest economic reviews along with annual reports of various financial and banking institutions.



## WI-FI ENABLED CAMPUS

The demand of the Digital India is to provide the latest information. With a view to abreast the students with the latest local and global updates in their field of interest, the college has a Wi-Fi enabled campus which facilitates access to the requisite information anytime, anywhere in the campus. It helps in maintaining continuity in learning and results in digital empowerment of students. Each student in the college is provided Wi-Fi access with a unique individual login ID and space on LAN server with a separate e-mail address.

## IT CENTRE

IT centre in the college campus is equipped with 450 computers, all licensed softwares, internet facility and high speed networking system. The centre also provides scanner, LCDs, printers, drivers, stylers, webcams for video conferencing and internet facility that ensures smooth inter-departmental and intra / inter-institutional information exchange. The students and college staff has an easy access to the IT Centre and are provided technical help through the trained IT staff of the centre.

## VIDEO CONFERENCING

To make interactive communication amongst student to teacher, student to student, teacher to teacher, we, at Subodh provide Video Conferencing facility. Video Conferencing has made its way into the teaching practices of the Subodh College. With this video conferencing setup, the Subodhians gain the benefits of knowledge from all over the world by interacting with researchers and other students at one click of a button. With this practice, the students develop an inherent flair for public speaking and grow into confident individuals, fully capable of putting across their points forth rightly.

## VSAT SMART CLASSROOMS

College has setup five smart classrooms with high-tech interactive boards and touch sensitive input devices including real time interaction facilities. The Smart Classroom has telecommunication facilities, with audio-video facilities to see, hear and talk to the students. The students can see, listen and participate in a lecture through a computer and on LCD projector connected to the VSAT receiver. Students interact with the faculty as spontaneously and naturally as in a regular classroom; raise queries; respond to polls and attempt multiple choice questions.

## LANGUAGE LAB

Language lab is accompanied with network teaching software designed to improve teaching environment. It has an audio-visual setting used as an aid of modern language teaching. It helps students to get involved in language learning exercise and gets more practice than otherwise possible in a traditional classroom environment. All students in the class can speak simultaneously without disturbing each other regardless of class size; enables a teacher to remotely control, monitor, broadcast and assist students directly. A breakthrough in the traditional teaching method with the rich teaching material contents, the digital language lab strengthens student's learning attitude by providing an interactive learning environment.

The modern language lab of the college equipped with LAN as well as separate audio cabling, computers with appropriate software for conducting language exercise, headsets that block outside sounds and disturbances, a media player and recorder for listening to audio and recorded speech and a server computer or a separate storage device to store lesson materials in a digital format.

## SOIL LAB

A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed between Department of Agriculture, Government of Rajasthan and our college for undertaking work on soil analysis under 'Soil Health Card Scheme'. Soil testing facilities are available and following major equipment's are present in the laboratory: Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer, Distillation unit, Flame photometer, Colorimeter, Spectrophotometer, pH meter etc. The 'Earn While Learn' concept is a part of this soil lab and students of our college utilize their free periods to learn the various instrumental techniques and also get a certificate for the same.

## MEDICAL HEALTH CARE

College provides health-related support services to the students, faculty and ministerial staff through its own medical room in the campus. It is well equipped with all first aid facilities for emergency cases. The college has tied up with the team of qualified doctors who provide their facility on call and one nursing staff is also employed on contract basis. Medical checkup facility for students and staff is available quarterly.

## BOYS AND GIRLS HOSTEL

The college has Wi-Fi enabled separate hostels for out stationed girls located at Sanganer. Hostel has capacity of 100 rooms with double and triple occupancy guarded by 24/7 security. The boy's hostel is situated at Mansarovar with the capacity of more than 50 students. Hygienic, homely and variety of food is provided to the students in the hostel dining room. Visitor room is also available for the parents or guardians to meet their wards. Recreation area for yoga, table tennis, carrom, chess and other indoor games are also available. LED screen, music player, DVD player, etc. have been made available in entertainment room. Newspapers and magazines have been subscribed by hostel administration for students. Both the hostel offers comfortable and homely atmosphere to its inmates.

## PARKING

A vast and properly guarded underground parking facility is available for both, faculty and students. More than 400 four wheeler vehicles can be parked at the same time. For the security of the vehicles, 24 hour CCTV cameras are active. Five guards are always on duty for security of vehicles.

## OUTDOOR STADIUM

Games are essential tool for healthy mind and body. Understanding this importance of sports, the college has a huge ground for outdoor games with seating capacity of 2500 spectators, where students can play all games like Cricket, Hockey, Football, Volleyball, Basketball, etc..The courts of Badminton, Basketball, Volleyball and Lawn Tennis are designed and developed on the basis of latest technology with international standards. The college has different types of athletic equipments to be used in various athletic events. The college has appointed specific coaches for each game, whose responsibility is to prepare our students for the state, national and international level tournaments and championships.

## INDOOR STADIUM

The college also has indoor stadium of 12500 sq. ft. which provides A-class indoor games facility for Short rifle shooting range, Badminton, Table Tennis with Carrom and Chess room.

**GYMNASJUM**

The college has a well equipped gymnasium equipped with Treadmill, Elliptical, Exercise Bike, Exercise Station (7 Station), Exercise Benches (Super Bench, Incline Bench, Flat, Preacher, Plain, Ab Bench), Dumbbells (500 Kg set), Weigh Plates, Racks, Accessories (Stepper, Gym Ball, Battle Rope, Latex Power Band Set, Gym Handle), Boxing Gloves & Bag etc. for maintaining the physical fitness and an exercise room with trained instructor.

## CAFETERIA

Cafeteria is an integral part of the campus which provides nutritious homely food to all students, faculty, staff members and visitors. Quality food is prepared under strict hygienic conditions. The food is served at affordable prices keeping all the sensitivities in consideration. The cafeteria remains open on all working days.

## ELEVATOR / RAMP FACILITY

For convenient movement of physically challenged in the college premises, the ramp facility is available at both blocks. The college also has an elevator, which is primarily available for the staff and physically challenged students for their movement to different floors in the college campus.

## UNIFORM DISTRIBUTION CENTRE

The college follows uniform code for each stream of Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses. The college teaching and non teaching staff also follows dress code which is fixed by the authorities. Since the college endorses philanthropic approach to serve the society, so the college provides one set of the college uniform free of cost to the students and on subsidized price to the faculty. The college has a Uniform Distribution Centre, from where a student can collect uniform of their respective sizes by presenting the uniform fee receipt at the counter.

## COMMON ROOMS

Institution also provides the facility of common room for boys and girls. The common rooms serve as a centre of recreational activities for the students as they indulge in discussions on various topics related to their interest area and also play various games like carrom, table tennis, chess etc. to de-stress themselves.

## REST ROOMS

The college is spread over six floors so clean and hygienic rest room facility is provided. The facility being used by faculty members as well as students also. Every rest room is equipped with all basic amenities.

## FIRE ALARMS AND SECURITY SYSTEM

The college building comprises of class rooms, lecture theatres, laboratories, seminar halls, kitchens and sports facilities. Each area poses a different type of fire and security risk, especially science labs that may contain flammable chemicals. College has effective and well maintained fire alarms and security systems and fully trained users thus, ensuring protection of students, buildings and equipment's.

## SOLAR PLANT

Energy is one of the most fundamental needs of our universe. Solar energy is the core source of all energies on earth. It is the most readily, freely available, non-polluting and the most abundant renewable energy source. The college has solar plant of 40 KW thus contributing in its own way towards the sustainable environment.

## CENTRAL INSTRUMENTATION LABORATORY

The college has created the Central Instrumentation Laboratory with an object of providing a central facility of latest and advanced analytical instruments for research. It has been playing a pivotal role in supporting the research activities of the different departments of Science, Commerce and Humanites. Central Instrumentation Laboratory of the college caters to the needs of the students, research scholars and teachers of the college in order to promote research activities. Central Instrumentation Laboratory is presently having instruments like X-ray diffractometer, FT-IR spectrophotometer, Fluorescence microscope, PCR machine, cooling centrifuge, centrifuge with rotator, Plant growth chamber, ultracentrifuge, optical microscope with camera, Gaussian software, Turnitin software, Matlab software etc.

## INNOVATION HUB

The college developed Innovation Hub under DBT Star Scheme. The college hosts the Innovation Hub to conduct innovative product, process and service testing that enhances industry competitiveness. It boosts regional economic development while serving as an experiential learning and resource hub for our students and the broader community. Some of the equipment's through which we are trying to do our best efforts to develop scientific and innovation skills among students are: Anharmonic Oscillator, Zeeman Effect, Newton Cradle, Air Canon, Kepler Law, Inclined motion, Manual Lift, Diffraction through water waves, Joe Cell etc.

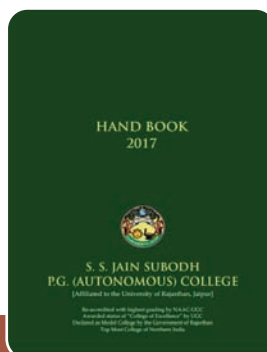

## Library Rules and Regulations

- Entry in the library is strictly through Identity cum Library card.
- Two books to UG level students and three books to PG level students can be issued at a time for 14 days and if the book is not in demand the same can be reissued for further 14 days.
- If the book is not deposited in scheduled time, a fine of Rs. 10/- per day per book will be charged.
- If the issued book is lost, the responsibility has to be borne by the borrower and he/she has to deposit another copy of the book of the same or the latest edition. If the book is not replaced, one has to deposit double cost of the book as a fine.
- Any damage caused to the library property and books of the library, in terms of writing, underlining or tearing the pages, is subjected to the disciplinary action as per the college rules.
- As the library is automated/computerized hence, any damage caused to the barcode of the book is subjected to a fine of Rs. 100/- for each book.
- Students have to pay Rs. 100/- for the loss of Identity cum Library card.
- Apart from the above rules, the library has a booklet of rules and regulations which is available at the counter.
- Some important rules and guidelines for this pandemic period:
  1. Students need to sanitize their hands before entering in the library
  2. Mask is compulsory to all in the library
  3. Students need to get their temperature checked before entering the library
  4. Sitting arrangement is with proper social distancing norms



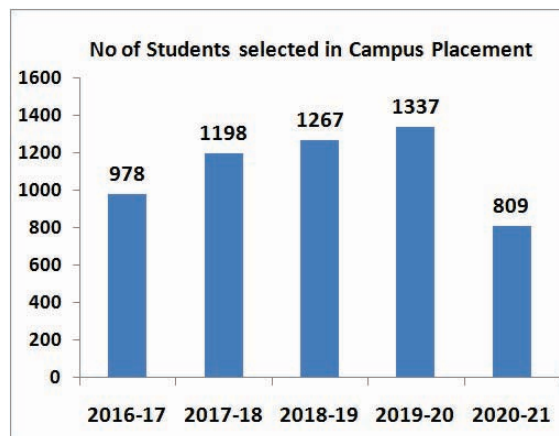

# SUPPORT AND SUSTENANCE

## INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

## SUBODH COLLEGE WOMEN GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

In accordance with the guidelines issued by the Women Commission and Government of Rajasthan, our campus has established the Anti-Sexual Harassment cell to handle various gender sensitive issues. The council aims at protecting the rights of the female faculties and students in order to create a safe and complacent environment. It addresses any kind of discrimination and harassment issues that might threaten the dignity of any of its constituents. An environment conducive for safe and secure learning is provided in the institution and a Drop Box has been placed outside the office so that students can easily discuss their issues on gender inequality, violence or any other problem.

## GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

## TOBACCO CONTROL CELL

## MENTOR-MENTEE CELL
